





Safety instructions/warnings

Failure to follow these safety rules could result in personal injury. Maximum pedestal drawer loading should comply with current ANSI/BIFMA specifications. When loading a mobile ped unit, the bottom drawer must be loaded first and then the top drawers last. When uploading reverse order. Contents and weight should always be evenly distributed along depth of drawer.


Overloading drawers could cause failure of drawer unit or work surface.


Unloading contents before moving a pedestal is recommended. In addition, when relocating mobile pedestals all drawers should be closed and locked to prevent accidental opening during relocation. When loaded, move unit carefully. Failure to do so could cause instability, product collapse, and or serious injury.

MOBILE STORAGE PEDESTAL USERS GUIDE

Standard and slim storage pedestals share the same features. Each has a top drawer and a larger bottom drawer. The pedestal moves on four casters, the front two of which have brakes to lock the pedestal in place. In addition, the bottom drawer has a smaller wheel that prevents tipping when the drawer is open.

A lock on the top drawer controls access to both drawers.
